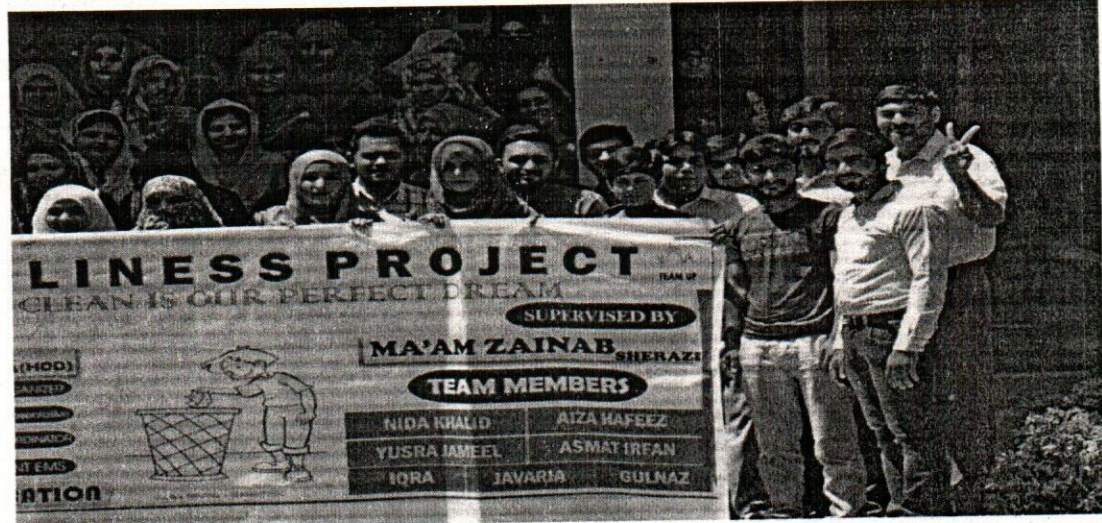

Rescue 1122: Basic Life-Saving Skills



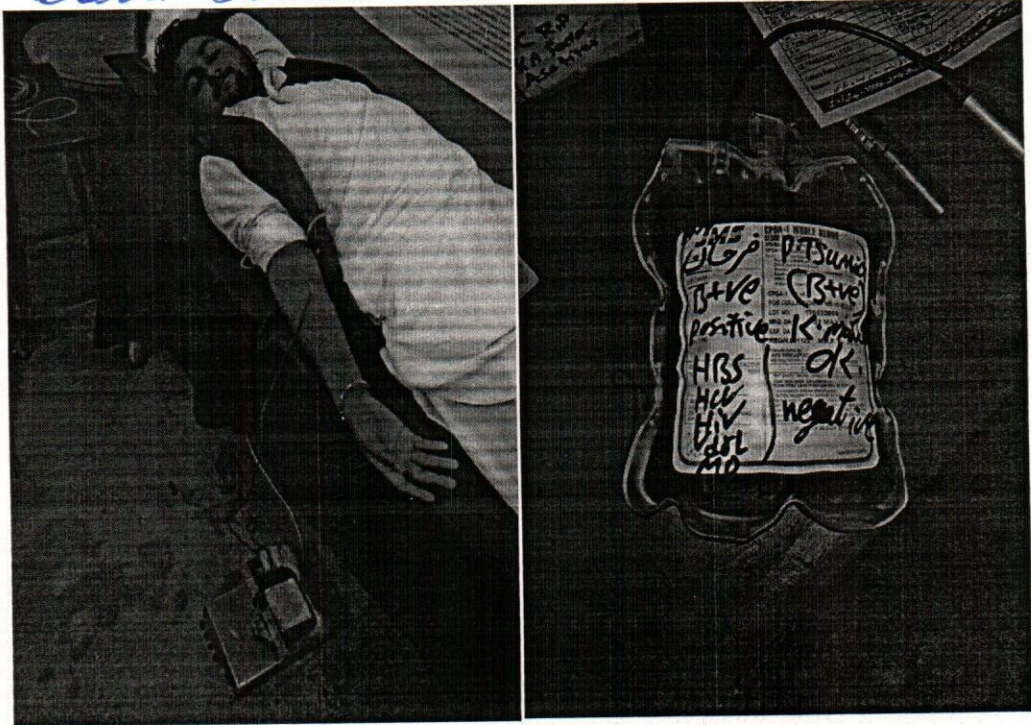
