- 5. Abusive or obscene language should not be used in the Answer Book.
- Unfair Means Case will be registered against the candidate(s) who refuses to obey Center Superintendent, changes his/her Roll No / Seat with another candidate, creates disturbance, stages walkout, resorts to pen
